

Report of the 128th Birth Anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar:

The 128th Birth Anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, an architect of the Indian Constitution, a well known political leader, eminent jurist, philosopher, historian, orator, writer, social reformer and an eminent scholar is being celebrated by IGNOU Regional Centre, Guwahati today the 10th April, 2019 by organising a lecture on the topic “**Concept of Social Justice of Dr.B.R. Ambedkar**” delivered by Dr. Manashi Sarma, Associate Professor, Department of Political Science, Aryavidyapeeth College Guwahati. The resource person narrated in brief the life history of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar and how he witnessed the plight of the untouchables and how he also suffered the same humiliation being born from a lower caste.

The speaker highlighted and discussed in detail the various social reform movements to eradicate the social injustice in the society by doing away with the caste system of the Hindu society. Because, Caste system leads to exploitation and exploitation leads to deprivation. For that Dr. B.R. Ambedkar encourages intercaste marriage, abolition of Brahmanical culture and shedding inferiority complex of the lower caste by codifying the Hindu laws. Then she goes on to say that he was the champion of human rights viz., right to speech, right to happiness, right to freedom of religion, equality. The resource person also dwelt on how Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, fought all through out his life for the dalits for their political, social and economic development.
